BENEFITS OVERVIEW

When you are hired from the U.S. Mainland on a transportation agreement you are entitled to additional benefits as a federal employee. The benefits include:

- Tax-free cost of living allowance (COLA), now at 13.22% of annual base pay.
- Locality pay set at 15.06% (taxable) of annual base pay using salary table 2017 Rest of U.S. (RUS) table.
- Non-foreign post differential (NFPD) set at 11.78% (taxable) of annual base pay.
- Relocation/Permanent Change of Station (PCS) costs may be paid by NAVFAC Marianas to include shipment of one privately owned vehicle.
- Temporary Quarters Subsistence Expense (TQSE) normally authorized to assist while locating a permanent residence. (New appointees are not eligible).
- Earn a minimum of four (4) hours of sick leave and (4) hours of annual leave per pay period plus 15 calendar days of home leave accrued annually.
- Home leave can only be used while in an overseas tour status.
- Use of DODEA Schools for dependents.

ADVANTAGES OF WORKING ON GUAM

- Convenient travel opportunities to exotic Asian destinations such as Singapore, Thailand, Korea, Hong Kong, Japan and many more countries.
- Authorized two environmental morale leave (EML) flights annually using the AMC Space-A travel program.
- After completing one full tour (24 months) eligible for Renewal Agreement Travel (RAT) which is one free roundtrip ticket to your US home of record.
- In addition to full privileges to enjoy all Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR) facilities and services, full commissary privileges and privileges at Navy and Army Air Force Exchanges.
- Eligible to reside in military family housing at prescribed rental rates. (Restrictions may apply).
- Use of U.S. Naval Hospital (pay basis).

Show Me the Money

- Current federal employees can carry over a maximum of 360 hours of annual leave.
- Current CONUS DoD federal employees have return rights for up to five years to your originating Command, or registration in the priority placement.
