## NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT AND FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR APRA HARBOR WATERFRONT REPAIRS, APRA HARBOR, NAVAL BASE GUAM

Pursuant to the Council on Environmental Quality Regulations implementing the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the United States (U.S.) Department of the Navy (Navy) is issuing this notice of availability (NOA) to advise the public of the availability of the Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and the Final Environmental Assessment (EA) evaluating the impacts associated with the Proposed Action: Apra Harbor Waterfront Repairs, Naval Base Guam. The Navy project would reconstruct the breakwater to implement long-term repairs within the existing breakwater footprint and would repair critical marina infrastructure in Sumay Cove that was damaged by the 2023 Super Typhoon Mawar.

A 15-day Draft EA review and comment period began with a public notice published for three consecutive days (March 25 through 27, 2025) in the *Pacific Daily News* indicating the availability of the Draft EA, the comment period start date on March 28, 2025, and the locations where public review copies of the document were available. The Draft EA was also made available on the following website: https://pacific.navfac.navy.mil/About-Us/National-Environmental-Policy-Act-NEPA-Information and at the Nieves M. Flores Memorial Library, in Hagåtña, Guam. The Draft EA public review and comment period initiated on March 28 and concluded on April 12, 2025; no comments were received from the public. Additionally, a public notice was posted from April 24, 2025, through May 23, 2025, on the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers–POH website (https://www.poh.usace.army.mil/Missions/Regulatory/Public-Notices/) for a 30-day public review and comment on the Navy's application for applicable permitting under the Clean Water Act and/or Rivers and Harbors Act.
