**Public Comments Accepted Through December 16 for PA Memo #1
in Support of the Military Relocation to Guam**

NIMITZ HILL, Guam - Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC) Marianas announced today the start of a 45-day public comment period for the establishment of native plant nurseries on Naval Base Guam, Telecommunications Site (NBGTS) Finegayan in support of the Military Relocation to Guam.

Comments are being accepted for the Department of Defense's (DoD) identification and evaluation of historic properties in the establishment of native plant nurseries detailed in Programmatic Agreement (PA) Memo #1. The comment period will remain open through Dec. 16, 2015 (Chamorro Standard Time).

The purpose of this project is to establish native plant nurseries to support conservation measures detailed in the Biological Assessment/Biological Opinion (BA/BO). The project will consist of a long-term nursery location and up to five temporary locations to facilitate easier access to planting in the forest enhancement areas.
