BLUF: Bottom Line Up Front

- Estimate ~\$415M in volume of work available for Fiscal Year 2022 (FY22)
- We aim to award 61% of our work to Small Business
- Opportunities with Small Business Multiple Award Construction Contracts (MACC) and Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contact vehicles
- Subcontracting opportunities for Small Businesses

- Strength Our SYSCOM Team







NAVFAC Northwest Execution Goals



- Fiscal Year 2022 execution goal is \$389.6M in construction, \$25.7M in design, \$100M in facilities support, and \$42M in environmental contracts
 - Zero safety accidents / Proactive involvement and accountability
 - 0% unplanned cost and schedule growth
 - High Performance and Sustainable Building Requirements in DoD UFC 1-200-02
 - Implement Low Impact Development (LID)
- Achieve Navy's Small Business Goals. NAVFAC Northwest FY22 Goals:

Small Business: 61%

HUBzone: 18%

SDVOSB: 11%

Small Disadvantaged: 47%

Women Owned: 4%

Typical Acquisition Approach-Tools in the Tool Box



- Set-Aside for Small Business (SB)
- Full and Open Competition (Unrestricted)
- Negotiated, Sole Source 8(a)
- Multiple Award Construction Contracts (MACC)
 - As many as 5 to 8 contractors selected
 - Four SB MACCs for projects \$100K to \$30M
 - Unrestricted MACC for Waterfront projects up to \$50M
- Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Contracts
 - Architect/Engineering, Environmental A/E, Facilities Planning
 - Regional Job Order Contract (JOC)
 - Field Office (e.g. Paving, Roofing)
- Facility Support Contracts (FSCs)
 - Base Operations Support Contracts (BOSC)
 - Regional Security
 - Janitorial and Grounds Maintenance

Design Tool Box



- Average about \$20M/year in design contracts
- Most design work is awarded through NAVFAC NW A-E IDIQ contracts
- Larger and/or specialized projects as stand-alone A-E contracts

Future Programs With Impact To Navy Shore Infrastructure



- Shipyard Infrastructure Optimization Program (SIOP) at Naval Base Kitsap
 - SIOP is a comprehensive approach to address the necessary infrastructure components (dry docks, capital equipment, facilities) at the nation's four public shipyards in order to improve Navy readiness and lethality
- COLUMBIA Class SSBN at Naval Base Kitsap
 - DoD's #1 acquisition program which will deliver a new class of ballistic missile submarines to replace the aging OHIO class
- CONSTELLATION Class Frigate at Naval Station (NAVSTA) Everett
 - New CONSTELLATION Class of Frigates is expected to homeport in the Pacific Northwest
