



OFF-BASE DRINKING WATER WELL SAMPLING NEAR NAVAL BASE KITSAP-BANGOR



The U.S. Navy is conducting drinking water well sampling near Naval Base Kitsap (NBK)-Bangor beginning in May 2025. The sampling is for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these drinking water wells due to past use of firefighting foam or other PFAS-containing materials on base. We believe the drinking water consumed at this property may come from a local well.

A separate notification letter asking the property owner's permission to sample the drinking water on this property has been sent to the owner, and no action is required on your part to schedule sampling. This sampling would be at no cost to you or the owner.

The Navy will continue to investigate the presence of PFAS at NBK-Bangor and evaluate if actions are needed. The Navy is committed to ensuring the safety of its neighbors. For more information, visit our website at:
